

Global Encounter: El Salvador

Dates: July 18th – July 26th and **required to be a part of the St. Louis Project July 8th -15th**

Leaving: Monday morning from St. Louis airport and arriving that evening in San Salvador, El Salvador.

Returning: July 26th in St. Louis

Trip Cost: \$1,450.00 (includes airfare, meals in country, ministry supplies, in country transportation, and lodging. *It also includes registration to the St. Louis Project, July 8th-15th*)

February 15th –Applications due plus a \$25.00 registration fee (This is over the trip cost and will be used for training expenses.)

February 25th –Late applications deadline, plus a \$50.00 registration fee

March 25th – \$800.00 of the trip cost is due (to secure airfare)

April 25th – 200.00 of trip cost due(\$1,000.00)

-copy of passport is due

May 25th – \$200.00 of trip cost due(\$1,200.00)

-1 VBS Lesson is due

June 25th –\$250.00 final total due(\$1,450.00)

-shot record is due

-3 VBS Lessons should be done

Weekend training session with worship will be hosted at FBC Arnold **March 4th -5th.**

What are we doing?

We will be doing VBS in the city of Chalchuapa and in mountain villages north from the city. We will also be doing youth rallies in the same locations. Students will be working together to develop their own lessons based from the Creation to the Church story sets. Other ministry will include youth leader training, pastor training (conducted by the adult leadership), church ministry, sports ministry, and door-to-door evangelism.

We will be visiting coffee plantations, the black sand beach, Mayan ruins, and shopping in a market for souvenirs.

Requirements/Expectations:

Completed and approved application (includes testimony, Christian life questions, health questions, etc.)

Age requirements: 16 and over at time of travel or 14 and over if accompanied with an adult or guardian.

Cover all costs, including trip, passport (a passport is required), and immunizations.

Attend all trainings, including a weekend in March and the St. Louis Project (July 8th-15th).

Complete all assignments: testimony sharing, learning C to C story (Creation to Church), VBS lessons, and team projects.
